

I am requesting funding for Pipeline Rehabilitation in Cabin John, Maryland in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority, located at 1385 Canal Street, Washington, D.C. 20003. The funding will facilitate a comprehensive restoration program that reinforces corroded sections of the recently collapsed Potomac Interceptor pipeline using a geopolymer solution. This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds, as it will help mitigate the risk of further catastrophic failures that will lead to severe environmental harm and costly emergency repairs that strain the fiscal resources of local, state, and federal governments, as illustrated by the previous failure. The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 603(c)(7) of the Clean Water Act.
