Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Public Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Montgomery County, located at 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850.

The funding would be used to install a mix of Level 2 charging (for long-term parking) and DC fast charging (for short-term parking) at two of the county's public parking garages in downtown Silver Spring in Montgomery County, Maryland. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because no public DC fast chargers are currently located in this census tract. Both garages where the charging units would be installed are in neighborhoods with many large apartment buildings and multi-family housing units, and where access to EV charging is a challenge. The county has received a significant number of requests for EV charging stations from residents in this area.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
