Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Goshen Road Safety Improvements, Montgomery County, Maryland, Sixth Congressional District in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is Montgomery County, located at 101 Monroe Street, Rockville, MD 20850.

The funding would be used for the design of safety improvements along Goshen Road from approximately 500 feet south of MD Route 124 to approximately 500 feet north of Emory Grove Road. The project will correct a sight distance issue associated with the hillcrest at the intersection of Emory Grove Road, where there is a substantial crash history. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because sixty-six crashes have occurred on Goshen Road between the intersection of Emory Grove Road and MD-124 since 2016. More than half of these resulted in an injury.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
